GUIDELINES FOR USE OF CROSS COUNTRY OBSTACLES

When using the MSEP Cross Country obstacles please observe the following guidelines in conjunction with the Terms and Conditions of Hire:

- 1. The safety and welfare of riders, horses and other attendees is paramount.**
 - ❖ **A minimum of 3 people must be in attendance when obstacles are being used and they must have a mobile phone and know how to give directions if Emergency Services are required.**
 - ❖ **At least one person must be appropriately qualified and experienced to supervise the jumping of obstacles for the level being used. An NCAS level 1, PCAQ level B or equivalently accredited coach must be in attendance when using any obstacle above Introductory (80cm) level.**
 - ❖ **The safety, competence and capability of each horse and rider combination must be assessed before attempting any obstacle.**
 - ❖ **Appropriate equipment and attire (including safety vests and helmets) must be used.**
- 2. Check the safety and suitability of the obstacle, approach, take-off, landing and departure areas before jumping any obstacle. Do not use any obstacles that you feel is not safe and report the obstacle/area to MSEP management.**
3. Crusher dust and mulch are stockpiled at the warm up area and are available to fill any holes or uneven surfaces as required.
4. After use, rake the take-off and landing areas flat with a metal rake.
5. Do not modify any obstacle without permission from MSEP management.
6. Report any incidents, damages or safety issues to MSEP management as soon as possible.
7. Keep the entry gate closed while the course is in use.
8. Dogs are not permitted in the cross country (bush) area when the course is in use and persons not involved in the cross country school should not enter the area.
9. Please contact MSEP management if you require assistance with any issues.
10. Users who do not comply with these guidelines may be refused future access to the course.
